#### **Maintenance Update**

### **Maintenance Summary**

As you all are aware, we no longer require annual recertifications.


We do however require annual vehicle and pet permits, an information sheet, and a household composition. These are still sent out on your move-in month.

## **Please Use Water Wisely**

Running a sprinkler for children to play in is not allowed.

If a member allows water to run into the street, the member will be charged for excessive usage.

Washing motor vehicles on cooperative property is prohibited.
