OPEN SESSION

Members signed in for the open session. Sheryl welcomed all and called the session to order at 6 p.m.

Maintenance Summary

Tim presented the maintenance report.

Yards are inspected on Tuesdays and re-checked on Fridays.

The Green Grass project started today. Front yards will be tilled and bad soil removed. Fresh soil mixed with fertilizer will be installed and yards leveled before the sod is planted. The lawn crew will water three times a week.

There was a break-in at the Maintenance Shop and all property locks are being changed.

Site Report

Alexis presented the site manager's report.

No memberships are for sale. Since the last board meeting, there have been five move-ins, one intent to vacate, five scheduled move-ins and one application pending.

Some notices from the office are being sent via email to members with email addresses.

Inoperable vehicles also are tagged and then towed after 96 hours.

Vehicles parked in a fire zone, in other members' numbered spaces or blocking members' spaces are towed immediately.

Be on Time: Pay on Time

Your carrying charges are due the first day of every month.

Paying is even easier now that members can make their payments online through the Resident Portal.

Carrying charges become delinquent on the 10th of the month and unpaid accounts are sent to the attorney on the 20th of the month.

The checks you write to Independence Square Townhouses are being deposited the day they are received. Please write your unit number on the check so that it will be properly credited.

An accounts receiveable program allows the checks to be cashed immediately.

When you write a check to pay the cooperative, you need to make sure that funds are in your account at that time.



Remember to Mow Fenced Backyards

Members are reminded that they are responsible for mowing fenced back yards.

Grass must be no higher than eight inches and the yard must be kept free of clutter.

If you receive notice from Maintenance to mow your yard, you will have 48 hours to do so. If not mowed during this time, Maintenance will mow and a fee will be charged.

If you leave for vacation, remember to make arrangements to have your yard mowed while you are gone.

If Maintenance has to mow, your account will be billed for the service.

Members Receive \$200 Referral Bonuses

Members of Independence Square Townhouses receive \$200 checks as referral bonuses when an applicant they recommend becomes a member.

There is no limit to the number of qualified referrals that can be made by a member.

We thank our members for their vote of confidence in our cooperative and for helping us attract qualifying new members.

Word-of-mouth recommendations are our best source of new members. When you tell others to consider Independence Square for their new home, it means that you enjoy living here and that you know someone else who would be a good neighbor for us.

The referral should be mentioned at the time of application.

The referring member will receive \$200 after the applicant moves in.

Inspections have started. The purpose is to help keep the property clean and uncluttered.

Please do not leave toys or other such items in the front yard when not in use.

Grass seed is available at the office and maintenance shop.
